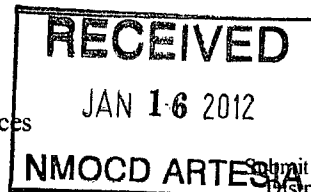

Initially 105bbls were released and we were able to recover 100bbls with a vacuum truck. All of the fluid was contained inside the walls of the facility. Tetra Tech will sample the spill site area to delineate any possible contamination from the release and we will present the NMOC D/BLM with a work plan for approval prior to any significant remediation work.

Please see below the detailed description of a release:

On 1-3-2012, the water tank ran over on the Dogwood Fed. #1 battery. The spill was caused by a miscommunication between the lease operator and the water hauling company. 105bbls of produced water was released into the dike. 100bbls of produced water was recovered and hauled to a disposal site.

We have to discuss due to the fact that we have an approved work plan for this location based on a previous spill. We were planning to start this remediation within the next two weeks.
