You have submitted a request on behalf of XTO Energy, Inc., for a 6 month exception to the requirement to use lined disposal tubing in this well due to a delay in the supply of this material.

The Division finds that granting this request will not harm fresh water or the environment and should be approved. XTO may install unlined disposal tubing at this time and replace it with lined tubing prior to September 5, 2012, at which time a new MIT shall be conducted under supervision of the Division's Aztec district office.

All requirements of the above referenced disposal permit and in Division Rules regarding injection or disposal remain in full force and effect.
