Chesapeake Operating, Inc. (OGRID No. 147179) hereby seeks administrative approval for amendment of NSL-6487, attached as **Exhibit A**, pursuant to the provisions of Division Rule 19.15.15.13 NMAC for an unorthodox well location for its PLU Phantom Banks 3 26 30 USA No. 1H to be located in Section 3, Township 26 South, Range 30 East, N.M.P.M., Eddy County, New Mexico. The proposed wildcat well is to be drilled at a surface location 300 feet from the South line with a projected penetration point 330 feet from the South line and 1980 feet from the East line of Section 3. 


