The commingled gas production shall be measured and sold at the Central Tank Battery (CTB) meter located in Unit L, Section 32, Township 22 South, Range 34 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico. Gas production from the wells is approved for off lease measurement and sales. Oil production shall not be commingled

Gas production from the wells shall be measured continuously with allocation meters before commingling with production from other wells. The allocation meters shall be calibrated semi-annually. Production shall be allocated back to each well on the basis of British Thermal Unit (BTU) values.
