Injection leak at SouthRedlake II.

Mike B. with OCD was notified by David Adkins with Talon at 12: 00 PM

Longitude 104.23183501 Latitude 32.79080830 A emergency One Call was placed.

Leak was beneath County Rd 226 ½ mile East from intersection County Rd. 225

Lost about 25 to 30 bbls of produced water, no water was able to be picked up.

Water ran down the side of the paved road about 100 yards on the North side of Rd.

On the South side of Rd. it ran about 100 Feet. All the water stayed on the right of way. Some of the pavement around the leak was bubbled up where water had gotten under it. That was one of the reasons we tore into the road to check for stability.

The Paved Road was cut in order to pull injection line with the old casing from beneath. All contaminated dirt was pick up and replaced with fresh dirt. New casing and new 2" injection line was installed and the Road was back- field to Eddie County specification. All contaminated dirt was hauled to disposal site ,also Talon check for chlorides during this process The water table was never compromised.

The injection line feed Wells on SRL II # 29, # 35 and # 37.
