COG Operating, LLC is hereby authorized to surface commingle oil and gas production from Penasco Draw; San Andres-Yeso Associated Pool (**50270**) from the following State Leases and wells.

Wells: Pinto 36 State Com Well No.1H (**API No. 30-015-39781**), Unit M, Sect. 36, T-18-S, R-25 E.

Pinto 36 State Com Well No. 2H (**API No. 30-015-39969**), Unit N, Section 36, T-18-S, R-25-E

Pinto 36 State Com Well No. 5H (**API No. 30-015-39970**), Unit M, Section 36, T-18-S, R-25-E.

Pinto 36 State Com Well No. 6H, (**API No. 30-015-39971**), Unit N, Section 36 T-18-S, R-25-E.

Pinto 36 State Com Well No. 3H (**API No. 30-015-39782**) Unit P Section 36, T-18-S, R-25-E.

**All in NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico**

The commingled oil and gas production from the wells detailed above shall be measured and sold at the Central Tank Battery (CTB), located in Unit M, Section 36, Township 18 South, Range 25 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico.

The oil and gas production from each well shall be measured with periodic well tests, and production shall be allocated back to each well based on these well tests. The oil and gas production is approved for off-lease measurement and sales.
