**Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.\***

A transport truck owned by Horizon Trucking ran over the S.W. corner of the 0 perm containment breaking a 3" poly line. The water transfer pump was shut down by the night pumper. The broken line and fitting were repaired the next day.

**Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.\***

Approximately 4050 sq.ft. of caliche pad and road along with approximately 6900 sq.ft. of pasture land was affected by the release. The water standing on the caliche pad area was removed with a vacuum truck. All of the fluid released into the pasture soaked into the ground. The spill area was reviewed with the BLM on 6/27/12. A remediation plan will be submitted along with the BLM recommendation.

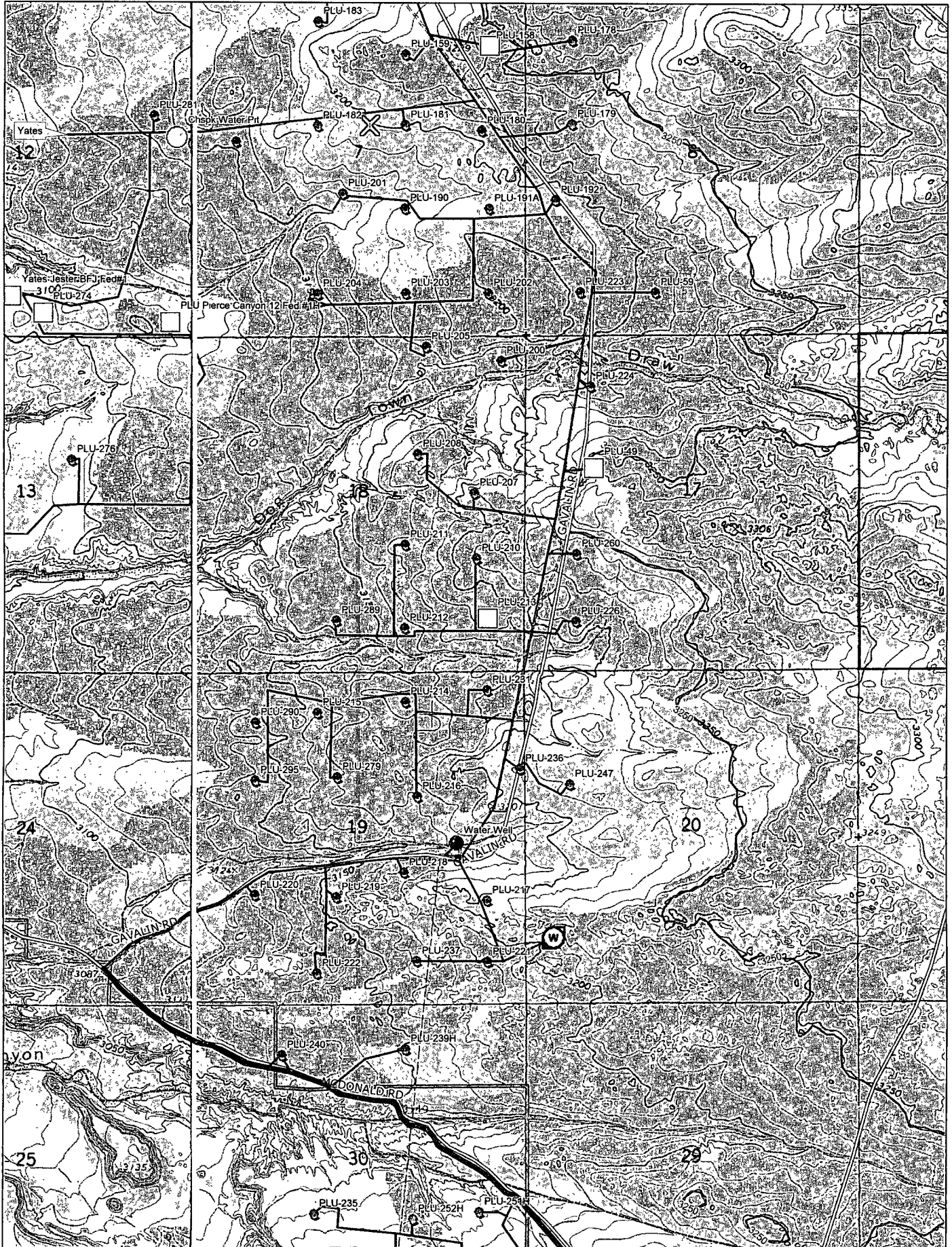

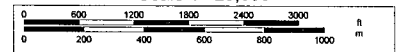
