

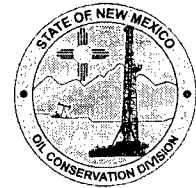

Yates Petroleum Corporation ("Yates") is hereby authorized to surface commingle oil and gas production from the Wildcat; Bone Spring Pool (**97816**), and from the following State Leases and wells.

Maduro BOZ State Com Well No. 1H (**API 30-015-37537**), Section 10, T-25-S, R-27-E.

Torpedo BOW State Com Well No. 1H (**API No. 30-015-37495**), Section 11, T-25-S, R-27-E.

All in NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico

The commingled oil and gas production from the wells detailed above shall be measured and sold at the Central Tank Battery (CTB), located in Section 10 Township 25 South, Range 27 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico.

The oil and gas production from each well shall be continuously measured with allocation meters before commingling with production from other wells. The allocation meters shall be calibrated monthly.


NOTE: This installation shall be installed and operated in accordance with the applicable Division Rules and Regulations. It is the responsibility of the producer to notify the transporter of this commingling authority.

FURTHER: The operator shall notify the Artesia District office of the Division prior to implementation of the commingling operations.

This approval is subject to like approval from the State Land Office (SLO) before commencing the commingling operations.
