Pride Energy Company is the operator of an oil and gas well at the site. A former drilling pit is a suspected source of a release of brines into the vadose zone and groundwater at the site. The volume of any release is unknown. Assuming that the release of brine occurred soon after drilling was completed in March 2005; the down gradient extent of groundwater impairment could be 30 ft to 120 ft southeast of the pit. The Stage 1 Abatement Plan includes (1) a description of the site, site maps, and discussion of the site history including the nature of the release, (2) a description of the site geology and hydrology, (3) results of previous investigations, (4) the proposed characterization program, which includes the installation of soil borings and/or monitoring well(s) to delineate the vertical and horizontal extent of the constituents of concern, (5) a quality assurance plan, (6) assessment of restoration options, and (7) a schedule of proposed activities.

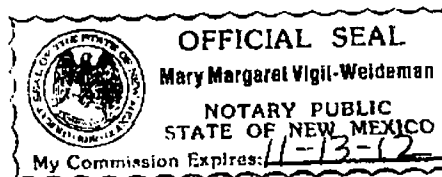
