

Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.\*

Remuda Energy, Oil Transporter, was pulling a load of oil off the tanks when it a hose failed and caused a spill. Trucker reversed flow back into tank to contain remaining oil

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.\*

An approximate size of 30' x 40' was impacted. The impacted area is located in front of the storage tanks. Soil from the pooling areas was excavated and disposed of at an NMOCD approved facility. Vertical and horizontal delineation samples will taken and analysis ran for TPH and BTEX once all contaminated material has been removed. Depth to Ground Water: >100' (approx. 585', per New Mexico State Engineers Office); Wellhead Protection Area: No; Distance to Surface Water Body: >1000'; SITE RANKING IS 0.
