Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.* A flow line ruptured releasing ~30 bbls oil and produced water with ~18 bbls recovered. An Emergency Response Team arrived at the release area and began continuous abatement of the impacted area.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.* Approximately 5,800 square feet of area was affected by the release of oil and produced water. Visibly stained soil was excavated and hauled away for disposal at a state approved facility. Soil samples were collected and submitted to Cardinal Laboratories for testing. Having received acceptable results and NMOCD approval, the affected area has been backfilled, and returned to proper conditions.

I hereby certify that the information given above is true and complete to the best of my knowledge and understand that pursuant to NMOCD rules and regulations all operators are required to report and/or file certain release notifications and perform corrective actions for releases which may endanger public health or the environment.
