Dear Mr. Cox:

Reference is made to the following: (i) your application that was submitted to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division ("Division") in Santa Fe, New Mexico on April 18, 2005 (administrative application reference No. pSEM0-510835426); (ii) the Division's initial response by e-mail Wednesday morning, May 11, 2005 from Mr. Michael E. Stogner, Engineer with the Division in Santa Fe for additional comments concerning this application; (iii) your response to Mr. Stogner by e-mail; and (vi) the Division's records in Aztec and Santa Fe: all concerning XTO Energy, Inc.'s ("XTO") request for an unorthodox gas well location in the Chacra formation for the existing Dawson "A" Well No. 1-G (API No. 30-045-31128) located 1500 feet from the South line and 475 feet from the West line (Unit L) of Section 4, Township 27 North, Range 8 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico. The SW/4 of Section 4 is to be dedicated to this well in order to form a standard 160-acre gas spacing unit for the Otero-Chacra Pool.

The application has been duly filed under the provisions of Division Rules 104.F.

By Division Order No. R-11898, issued in Case No. 12978 on February 11, 2003, XTO received authorization to drill to and complete the above-described well in the Blanco-Mesaverde (72319) and Basin-Dakota (71599) Pools at an unorthodox gas well location for both pools.

It is further understood that XTO now indents to perforate the Dawson "A" Well No. 1-G uphole in an attempt to establish gas production within the Chacra interval.

The location of this well within the Otero-Chacra Pool is also considered to be unorthodox, pursuant to Division Rule 104.C (3).

By the authority granted me under the provisions of Division Rule 104.F (2), the above-described unorthodox gas well location within the Otero-Chacra Pool for XTO's Dawson "A" Well No. 1-G is hereby approved.

Further all provisions of Division Order No. R-11898 shall remain in full force and affect until further notice.

Jurisdiction of this cause is retained for the entry of such further orders as the Division may deem necessary.
