By Order No. NSL-6636 dated June 7, 2012 the Division authorized Apache Corporation ("Apache") to drill its D State No. 79 at an unorthodox well location in the Artesia Glorieta-Yeso Pool (96830) 170 feet from the South line and 990 feet from the East line (Unit P) of Section 26, Township 17 South, Range 28 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico.

Due to additional surface obstructions, the D State No. 79 had to be moved 100' feet south of the originally proposed unorthodox location. The new well location is 70 feet from the South line and 990 feet from the East line (Unit P) of Section 26.

The D State No. 79 will be dedicated to an existing standard 40-acre spacing and proration unit comprising the SE/4 SE/4 of Section 26. This unit is currently dedicated to Apache's: i) existing D State No. 2 (API No. 30-015-31421) located at a standard well location 990 feet from the South line and 430 feet from the East line; ii) existing D State No. 51 (API No. 30-015-38585) located at a standard well location 900 feet from the South line and 990 feet from the East line; and iii) existing D State No. 59 (API No. 30-015-38470) located at an unorthodox well location 290 feet from the South line and 175 feet from the East line.

The Artesia Glorieta-Yeso Pool is currently governed by Division Rule 19.19.15.9 which requires standard 40-acre oil spacing and proration units with wells to be located no closer than 330 feet to the outer boundary of the spacing unit.

The affected offset tracts are the NE/4 NE/4 and NW/4 NE/4 of Section 35, Township 17 South, Range 28 East, NMPM, (see attached plat). These affected offset tracts are operated by Apache in the Artesia Glorieta-Yeso Pool. The working interest ownership between the drill tract and the affected offset tracts is common. Consequently, notice of this application is not required to any party.

Attached is a Form C-102 showing the proposed well, spacing unit and other existing or proposed wells in the spacing unit, a plat showing the affected offset acreage, a vicinity map, and a copy of Order No. NSL-6636.

In summary, approval of the proposed amendment to NSL-6636 will provide Apache Corporation the opportunity to recover additional oil and gas reserves from the Artesia Glorieta-Yeso Pool underlying the SE/4 SE/4 of Section 26 that may otherwise not be recovered by the existing or proposed producing wells, thereby preventing waste, and will not violate correlative rights.
