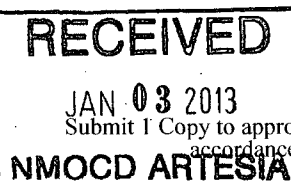

Remediation Plan: Site will be assessed on 11/26/12 and a work plan will be submitted.

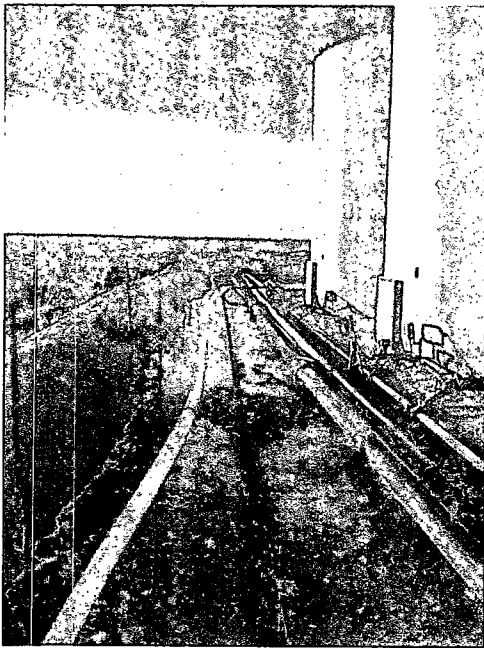

- Transmitter failure

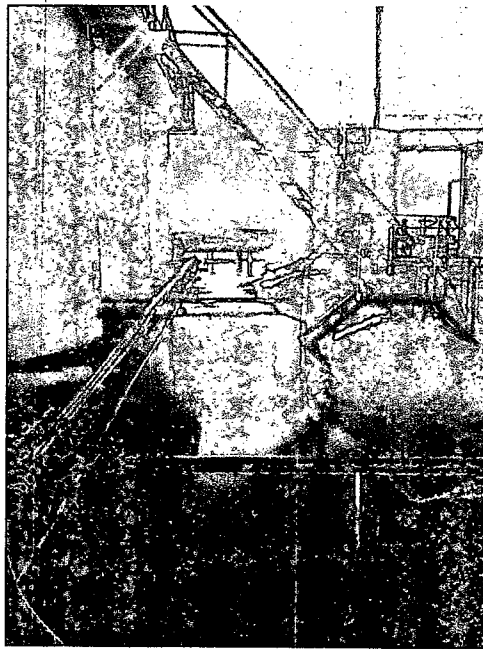
