You have requested to re-complete this well at an unorthodox oil well location described above, in the referenced pool or formation. This location is governed by the Special Rules and Regulations for the Totah Gallup Pool, which provides for 80-acre units, with wells located within 150 feet from the center of a quarter-quarter section. This location is more less than 150 feet from the center of the NE/4 NE/4 of Section 23.

Your application has been duly filed under the provisions of Division Rules 15.13 [19.15.15.13 NMAC] and 4.12.A(2) [19.15.4.12.A(2) NMAC].

It is our understanding that you are seeking this location in order to utilize an existing wellbore.


It is also understood that notice of this application to offsetting operators or owners is unnecessary due to common ownership.

Pursuant to the authority conferred by Division Rule 15.13.B, the above-described unorthodox location is hereby approved.
