You have requested to drill these horizontal wells at unorthodox well locations described above in the referenced pool or formation. This location is governed by the Special Rules for the Basin Mancos Gas Pool, as set forth in Order R-12984, and by Rule 15.16.14.B(2) [19.15.16.14.B(2) NMAC] concerning directional wells in designated project areas. This location is unorthodox because portions of the proposed completed interval are less than 660 feet from an outer boundary of the project area.

Your application has been duly filed under the provisions of Division Rules 15.13 [19.15.15.13 NMAC] and 4.12.A(2) [19.15.4.12.A(2) NMAC].

It is our understanding that you are seeking these locations for engineering reasons, in order to efficiently drain hydrocarbon reserves within this project area.
