

Pursuant to Division Rule 19.15.15.13, Mewbourne Oil Company ("Mewbourne") respectfully requests administrative approval of an unorthodox oil well location for its proposed Zircon 1 LI State No. 1H. This well will be drilled as a horizontal development oil well in the Turkey Track-Bone Spring Pool (60660).

The Zircon 1 LI State No. 1H will be dedicated to a 160-acre spacing and proration unit ("project area") comprising the N/2 S/2 of Section 1. There are currently no other existing Bone Spring producing wells within the project area.

The Turkey Track-Bone Spring Pool is currently governed by Division Rule 19.19.15.9 which requires standard 40-acre oil spacing and proration units with wells to be located no closer than 330 feet to the outer boundary of the spacing unit, or in the case of a horizontal well, no closer than 330 feet to the outer boundary of the project area.

The Zircon 1 LI State No. 1H will penetrate the Bone Spring formation at or near the surface well location, which is unorthodox for this pool. The bottomhole location of the well is standard.

The unorthodox surface location is necessary due to a buried pipeline within the NW/4 SW/4 of Section 1.

The Zircon 1 LI State No. 1H encroaches upon the following existing 160-acre spacing and proration units ("project areas") in the Turkey Track-Bone Spring Pool (See attached map). All three of the existing affected project areas are operated by Mewbourne. Please note that the working interest ownership between the N/2 S/2 and the S/2 S/2 of Section 1 is common. Please further note that the working interest

ownership between the N/2 S/2 of Section 1 and the S/2 of Section 2 is not common. Consequently, Mewbourne is providing notice of this application, pursuant to Division rules, to all working interest owners within the S/2 of Section 2.

Project Area 1: S/2 S/2 of Section 1-19S-29E; Currently dedicated to Mewbourne's Zircon 1 State No. 1H;

Project Area 2: S/2 S/2 of Section 2-19S-29E: Currently dedicated to Mewbourne's Zircon 2 State Com No. 1H;

Project Area 3: N/2 S/2 of Section 2-19S-29E: Currently dedicated to Mewbourne's Zircon 2 LI State No. 1H;

Working interest owners within the S/2 of Section 2 include Snow Operating, Inc., Cross Border Resources, Inc., and JKM Energy, LLC.

Attached is a Form C-102 showing the proposed well and proposed project area. Also attached is a map showing the affected offset acreage, a lease map and an offset working interest owner notice letter.

In summary, approval of the application will provide Mewbourne Oil Company the opportunity to recover additional oil and gas reserves from the Turkey Track-Bone Spring Pool underlying the N/2 S/2 of Section 1 that may otherwise not be recovered, thereby preventing waste, and will not violate correlative rights.


