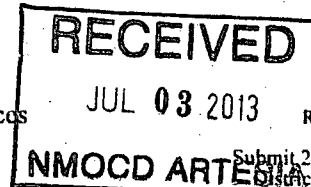

#### Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.\*

Xcel electricity went down, causing the hi-speed transfer pump to go down. Produced water could not equalize fast enough to handle water volume coming into the battery. Shut off water flow stream into facility until tanks were equalized and the power had been restored.

#### Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.\*

Initially 140bbls of produced water were released due to a power outage we were able to recover (03bbls) with a vacuum truck. The release was completely contained inside the lined facility walls of the tank battery. All free fluid has been recovered. Any contaminated gravel has been removed and we have replaced with fresh gravel as necessary. The facility has been returned to its prior condition.

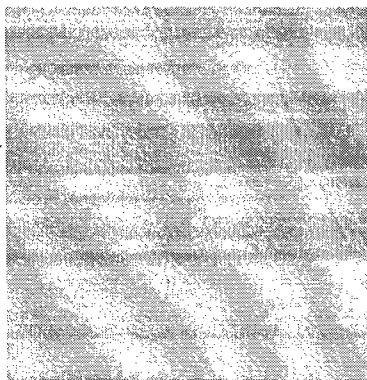

Mr. Bratcher:

At approximately 5:00 p.m. on 6/24/2013, a produced fluid release was discovered at the above-referenced facility. The fluid was contained inside the battery which is lined with 40 mil plastic. An estimated 140 barrels of produced fluid was released. The cause of the release is currently under investigation. We will follow up within 15 days with a C-141 Report.
