While installing another pipeline a Trackhoe struck a 6" mainline.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.\*

Initially 332bbls of produced water was released from a 6" main line. We were able to recover 330bbls with vacuum trucks. The spill area was mainly contained in a 30'x5' trench and a run off area of 40'x5'. Tetra Tech will sample the spill site area to delineate any possible contamination from the release and we will present the NMOCD/BLM with a work plan for approval prior to any significant remediation work.

I hereby certify that the information given above is true and complete to the best of my knowledge and understand that pursuant to NMOCD rules and regulations all operators are required to report and/or file certain release notifications and perform corrective actions for releases which may endanger public health or the environment.
