
Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.\*

Back pressure on the compressor inlet piping resulted in the opening of the pressure relief valve. While safely relieving the line pressure, natural gas and liquids were expelled through the relief valve and carried by the wind across the Station and into an adjacent pasture.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.\*

An area measuring approximately 80 feet in width and 200 feet in length was affected by the airborne liquids. This release will be remediated to NMOCD regulatory guidelines.
