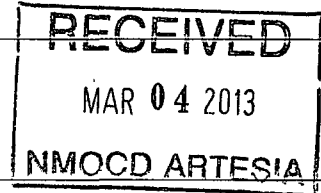

A third-party well connected to the Enterprise Gathering system introduced high H2S gas to the system. To eliminate this gas, the gathering lines needed to be purged. Volume includes the gathering line and station residual volumes.

Line was purged to reduce the H2S level at the South Carlsbad Compressor Station below the permitted limit of 4 ppm.

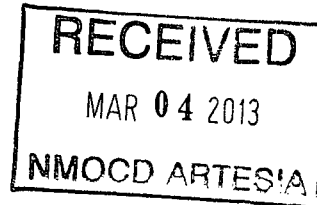
