Suspected internal corrosion. The line was isolated, blown-down and scheduled for repair. Maintenance excavation on 12SEP2013 found a release of pipeline liquids.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.*

Any impacted area will be determined when the line is excavated; landowner will be notified. Current observation shows no release of liquids to the surrounding area. Repair schedule is not known at the time of this report. Impacted soils have been removed and segregated. Updates and a final report are pending.
