Plunger on triplex pump broke. Replaced the triplex pump.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.\*

Initially 10bbls of oil and 30bbls of produced water were released due to a mechanical failure on the triplex pump. Causing the water tank to overflow. We were able to recover 7bbls of oil and 25bbls produced water with a vacuum truck. The spill occurred in a unlined facility. All free fluid has been recovered. Tetra Tech will sample the spill site area to delineate any possible contamination from the release and we will present a work plan to the NMOCD/BLM for approval prior to any significant remediation work.
