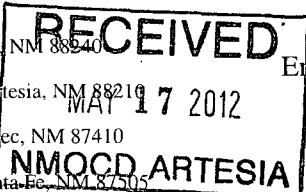

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.* Approximately 300' around the rupture was covered in iron sulfide which was in the pipeline. Oxy will be replacing all of line 4 main line with 12" pipe. We are waiting for the BLM to inspect the area and offer guidance on cleanup procedures.
