

Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.\*

A pump seal failure in the #1 Unit is the cause of the release. Pumping sources immediately shut-down. Failure resulted in a vertical spray of crude oil mist. Impacted soils at the source was excavated and placed on plastic.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.\*

SESI, Hobbs, NM, identified the release while setting up for another project onsite. SESI has excavated impacted soil (placing on plastic) and will oversee delineation and remediation activities.

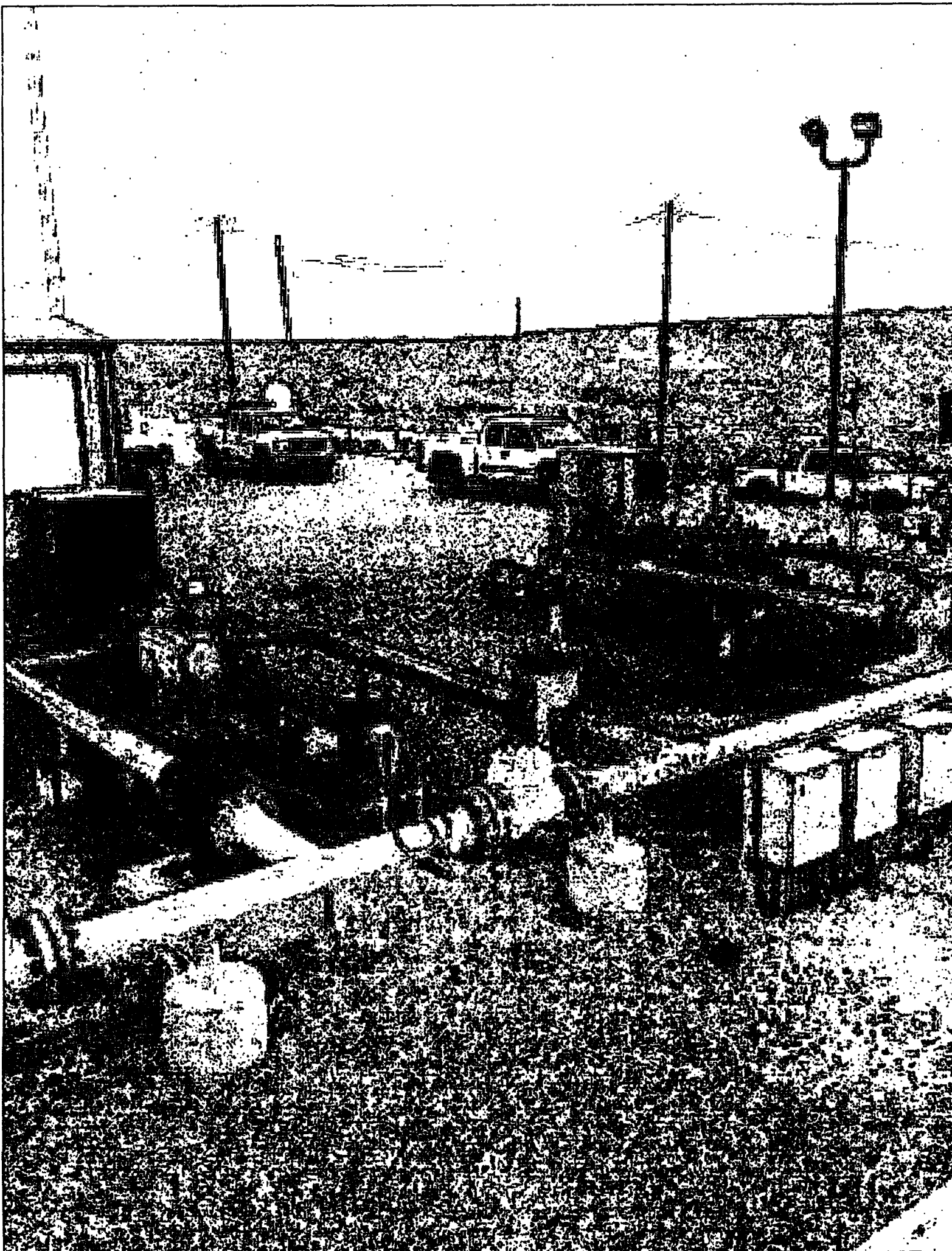
