

Yes X No If a Watercourse was Impacted, Describe Fully.* Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.* At approximately 1450 hrs. on 11/4/2013 at the intersection of NM 82 and CR 206 a Remuda oil transport truck carrying 179.9 bbls of crude oil was involved in a one vehicle rollover accident. The tractor remained upright but the trailer rollover to the right \(\frac{3}{2} \) of a complete roll and came to rest west the intersection, on the shoulder area. The bottom of the tanker was ripped open by the truck frame and the contents spilled out onto the ground to the immediate west of the rollover location and pooled, then ran south along a ditch area. 22 bbls remained in the tanker and was removed by a second Remuda tanker vehicle. 13.5 bbls was recovered from the ground where oil had pooled, as soon as NMSP authorized. TNT tractor contractors were notified within 1 hour of the accident to respond to the spill and begin soil recovery. This work began at approximately 1800 hrs. about 3 hours after the accident. Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.* The affected area is reported to be private land owned by Bogle Farms. The land owner was contacted and advised that clean up and remediation of the area had already begun and would continue. The affected area begins at the southwest corner of the intersection of NM 82 & CR 206 in eddy county, approximately 9 miles east of Riverside, NM. The estimated spill area is approximately 60' west of the intersection, and 25' wide. The spill then ran along a depressed area to the south for approximately 75' and 10' wide. The landowner contacted Remuda the following afternoon and stated he was pleased with our efforts and the response. At present, the affected soil has been removed and transported to Lea Land farm for disposal. TNT tractor contractors will await results of soil sampling before they begin backfill work at the location. I hereby certify that the information given above is true and complete to the best of my knowledge and understand that pursuant to NMOCD rules and regulations all operators are required to report and/or file certain release notifications and perform corrective actions for releases which may endanger public health or the environment. Hello Mr. Bratcher, OCCTD# 286911

My name is TJ Smith and I am the Safety Officer for Remuda Energy Transportation, LLC in Artesia, NM.

Yesterday at approximately 1500 hrs. we were notified about a truck crash at the intersection of NM HI way 82 (the Lovington HI way) and CR-206. The accident involved one of our tanker transport vehicles and was loaded with 179.9 bbls of crude oil.

Our driver was the only vehicle involved in this accident and he was un injured, but the tank vessel was ruptured and spilled 157.9 bbls onto the shoulder of the roadway and into a field beside the roadway.

22 bbls remained in the tanker and was recovered by one of our vehicles. 13.5 bbls was recovered from the ground which left a total of 144.5 bbls. spilled and not recovered.

Remuda contracted TNT tractor to remediate the soil and they began this operation within three hours of the accident. TNT is at the present time continuing to remediate the ground soil and transport it from the location with intention of replacement of the soil with good top soil.

Soil samples and the C¹141 form will be sent within eleven days.

This letter is to notify you of the spill and the work being done immediately to remove the contaminated soil.
