We have received your letter of May 10, 1996, wherein you requested our approval to downhole commingle the Blanco Mesaverde and Blanco Pictured Cliffs pools' production from the above-captioned well.

Since it appears that there will be no loss of revenue to the State of New Mexico's beneficiaries from your proposed operation, the Commissioner of Public Lands hereby grants approval to your request. Our approval is given with the understanding that the Commissioner of Public Lands reserves the right to amend or withdraw his approval should this operation prove to be unprofitable to the state at any time in the future. Our approval is subject to like approval by the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division.

We understand that you will submit the actual percentage allocations from the production for the two zones once the pitot gauges have been obtained.
