Allocation Formula Method:

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A Perforation Efficiency Log was run on this well to determine individual zone contribution on 5/16/96. At this time the well had a pitot gauge of 1,150 MCF/D.

**Results of the log yielded the following results:** 

Pictured Cliffs Contribution - 25% (288 MCF/D)

Mesa Verde Contribution - 75% (862 MCF/D)
