

County road crew was blading the road, the lines were marked and underground. The blade struck the line causing the release. Removed all free standing		
fluid and bladed the road. The entire release was on the county road. Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.*		
Initially 70bbls of produced water were released due to a county crew striking a transfer line. We were able to recover 65bbls of produced water with a vacuum truck. All free fluids have been recovered. Concho will have the spill site sampled to delineate any possible contamination from the release and we will present a remediation work plan to the NMOCD for approval prior to any significant remediation work.

Mr. Bratcher,

Per our discussion on the phone on January 21, 2014, you had asked me to put together a brief summary of the events that took place on January 16, 2014 regarding the SRO SWD #103 release. I have attached the C-141 as an Initial – Final as requested.

On January 16, 2014, a maintainer operated by the county struck a produced water transfer line going to our SRO SWD #103 to our SRO SWD #101. The line was buried under the road and painted on the edges where the line was exposed. The county had all the equipment on site to recover all fluids and affected soil. The entire release was contained on the dense caliche county road. A COG representative went out to inspect the release after the work was completed. There are no signs of any release.

Mr. Bratcher:

At approximately 3:15 p.m. on <u>01/16/2014</u>, a produced fluid release was discovered near the above-referenced well. An estimated 70 bbls of produced fluid was released. The cause of the release is currently under investigation. We will follow up within 15 days with a C-141 Report. GPS coordinates, legal description and driving directions are listed below.
