Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.\*

One of the caps on one of the pistons on the jet pump backed off causing 15 barrels of produced water to spill on the ground.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.\*

The lease operator was doing his daily lease check and upon arrival he found approximately fifteen barrels of produced water had spilled to the ground. Lease operator said it happened sometime during the night. It was determined that one of the caps on one of the pistons on the jet pump backed off causing produced water to overflow to the ground. The lease operator shut the lease in and called the assistant foreman that was in charge. A vacuum truck was called immediately for clean-up. Approximately 10bbls were recovered from the ground. Talon LPE was contacted to perform the site assessment and soil sampling activities. The size of the spill area was approximately 100 feet by 60 feet. The release was isolated on location only.
