

Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.*

Water tank overflowed due to a faulty check valve. We have replaced the check valve with a new one.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.*

Initially 33bbls of produced water were released. We were able to recover 33bbls of produced water with a vacuum truck. The spill was contained inside the lined facility. All free fluid has been recovered. Any contaminated gravel has been removed, the liner has been steam cleaned and we has replaced with fresh gravel as necessary. This location has been returned to its prior condition.
