

Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.*

Heater treater pressured up causing the gasket on the gasket to blow out on the fire tube flange. Replaced gasket on the fire tube.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.*

Initially 60bbls of produced water were released. We were able to recover 55bbls of produced water with a vacuum truck. The spill was contained inside the lined facility. All free fluid has been recovered. Any contaminated gravel has been removed, the liner has been steam cleaned and we has replaced with fresh gravel as necessary. This location has been returned to its prior condition.
