

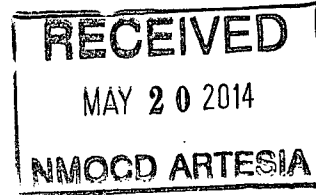

3" Polyline weld failed. Cut out bad section of line and refused polyline.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.*

Initially 130bbls of produced water were released. We were able to recover 125bbls of produced water with a vacuum truck. All free fluids have been recovered. Concho will have the spill site sampled to delineate any possible contamination from the release and we will present a remediation work plan to the NMOCD for approval prior to any significant remediation work.

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
