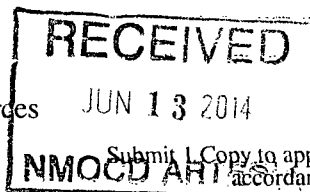

Water tanks on location ran over and spilled into the lined containment surrounding the water tanks. The answering service never received an alarm, therefore the lease operator never received an alert about the overflow. It is suspected the issue was a result of bad weather as storms had passed through recently. Issues regarding the alarm system are being researched.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.*

The 30BBLS of produced water that spilled from the water tank all spilled into lined containment. All 30BBLS were recovered.
