CAUSE: Push-weld failure; likely corrosion.



ACTION: The line was blown down at the weld. Line was repaired with a clamp.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.*

All gas was lost to atmosphere.

Clean up action : Contaminated soil was removed and disposed. Confirmation samples were taken and showed the spill area had been excavated below the OCD RRAL's. NMOCD Region 1 (G. Leking) provided approval (5/12/2014) and the excavation was refilled with clean soil obtained from the landowner.
