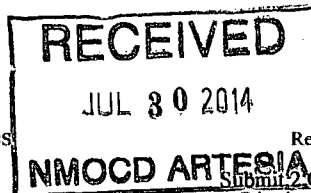

Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.* ☐ A steel injection line leaked due to corrosion causing a release of 43 barrels of produced water. All wells were shut in and the flow line was repaired. No fluids were recovered. Talon/LPE was contacted for initial site assessment and to generate a work plan.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.* ☐ The release flowed down the draw. A backhoe was used to berm the flow path to prevent further migration.

Please accept this as formal notification of new release for Lime Rock Resources. 43 bbls of produced water were released yesterday evening into a draw near the West Red Lake Unit 13. An emergency one call is being made, initial remedial actions planned will be to construct a catch basin at the bottom of the release and to flush water into the draw/flow path, capturing the released fluids in the containment. The water will be vac'd out and disposed. Soil sampling and site assessment activities will follow. We will submit a formal C141 later today. Please let me know if you have any questions. Thank you.
