Line break resulted in release of approximately 8 bbls of fluid. Following discovery of leak line was shut in. On 6-24-14 160' of the pipeline was replaced. Trench samples were taken and well samples were taken to lab for verification of clean.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.\*

Dug out all of the contaminated area and hauled off to Sundance. Approximately 1600 ft<sup>2</sup> was affected. Samples from lab came back clean and after talking with OGD we were approved for backfill. We then backfilled and leveled remediated area.
