A steel flowline failed due to corrosion. Replaced the steel flowline.

Initially 2bbls of oil and 4bbls of produced water were released from a steel flowline that developed a hole due to corrosion. We were able to recover 1bbl of oil and 2bbls of produced water with a vacuum truck. All free fluids have been removed. A work plan will be presented to the NMOCD/BLM for approval prior to any significant remediation work.
