A hole in the bottom of the oil tank caused a release. The tank was emptied and repaired. A vacuum truck was dispatched was to pick up standing fluids.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.\*  
The impacted area occurred within the containment in front of and to the south of the tanks. Heavily impacted material was excavated and disposed of at an NMOCD approved facility. Concho will have the spill site sampled to delineate any possible contamination from the release and we will present a remediation work plan to the NMOCD for approval prior to any significant remediation work.
