Approximately 10bbls were recovered from the ground.									
Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.* The impacted area in the vicinity of S-1, S-2, S-3, S-5, test pit location TP-1 and TP-									
2 was excavated to a depth of 1-foot deep. The impacted area in the vicinity of S-4 and TP-3 was excavated to a depth of 0.5-feet									
deep. The impacted area in the vicinity of TP-4 was excavated to and depth of 2-feet deep in accordance with NMOCD and BLM									
approved work plan. All the contaminated soil was transported to Lea Land, LLC. The excavated areas were then backfilled with new caliche; machine compacted and contoured to match the surrounding location. No further action is required.
