Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.\*  
The 3" poly line was cut by a road grader operated by MJ Services. The well was shut in and the damaged section of pipe was cut out and replaced.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.\*  
The spill impacted approximately 3500 sq.ft. of caliche lease road and misted approximately 400 sq.ft. of pasture. The saturated soil was scraped up and stockpiled at the Hudson Federal Battery pending removal. Clean caliche was used to re-cover the exposed line.  
The spill will be cleaned up in accordance to the NMOCD and BLM remediation guidelines.
