
Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.*

The release was caused by a crack in a PW flowline. The line was isolated and fused back together. A vacuum truck was dispatched to pick all standing fluid.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.*

The impacted area is 425' along the road. All standing fluids were disposed of at an NMOCD approved facility. Concho will have the spill site sampled to delineate any possible contamination from the release and we will present a remediation work plan to the NMOCD for approval prior to any significant remediation work.
