
Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.*

A blowout from the upper packing and stuffing box caused the release. Well was shut off and vacuum truck(s) and roustabout crew were called.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.*

An approximate area of 50' X 50' (well pad) and 150' X 10' (off pad). Vacuum trucks were used to recover the remaining oil and all produced water. Well pad scraped and impacted soils will be hauled to a NMOCD facility. Off pad impacted soils to be excavated and hauled to an NMOCD facility. Vertical and horizontal delineation samples will be taken and analysis ran for TPH & BTEX (chlorides for documentation). If initial analytical results for TPH & BTEX are under RRAL's (site ranking is 0) a Final Report, C-141 will be submitted to the OCD requesting closure. If the analytical results are above the RRAL's a work plan will be submitted to the OCD. Depth to Ground Water: > 100' (approximately 150', Section 11, T22S-R31E, per Trend Map), Wellhead Protection Area: No, Distance to Surface Water Body: >1000', SITE RANKING IS 0.
