

Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.* Release was caused by a poly flow line failure causing oil and produced water to spray across the pad and surrounding areas. Fluid pooled on lease road and a small area next to the road. Well was shut in and poly line isolated. Vacuum truck was dispatched and a crew was called in to repair line. Impacted area to be excavated and areas impacted by spray mist to be treated with Micro Blaze.		
Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.* An approximate area of 50' X 60' was impacted. Impacted soils to be scraped up and taken to an NMOCD approved facility. Vertical and horizontal delineation samples will be taken and analysis ran for TPH & BTEX, Chlorides will be run for documentation. If initial analytical results for TPH & BTEX are under RRAL's a Final Report, C-141 will be submitted to the OCD requesting closure. If the analytical results are above the RRAL's a work plan will be submitted. Depth to Ground Water: >100' (approximately 325', Section 32-T22S-R32E, per Trend Map), Wellhead Protection Area: No, Distance to Surface Water Body: >1000', SITE RANKING IS 0.
