
Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.*

Sight glass on knockout broke causing release. Vacuum truck and backhoe called.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.*

An approximate area of 20' X 70'. Sight glass replaced. Oil & produced water contained within berm, battery lined with 20 mil liner. Vacuum truck recovered oil & produced water, remaining oil and produced water suspended within impacted gravel, gravel being removed and hauled to an OCD approved facility. Liner inspected. **Depth to Ground Water: > 100' (340', Section 14, T22S-R23E, NMOSE); Wellhead Protection Area: No; Distance to Surface Water Body: >1000'; SITE RANKING IS 0. Based on enclosed information, Yates Petroleum Corporation requests closure.**
