XTO Energy Inc. has requested to amend Division Order No. PLC-404 to authorize use of the subtraction method for the Bell Federal Gas Com "A" No. 1E and Bell Federal 12 No. 2 wells. The Division has reviewed your application and hereby grants your request.

The Division Order No. PLC-404 is hereby amended to authorize XTO Energy Inc. (OGRID 256965) to surface commingle gas production from the following pools located in located in Section 12, Township 30 North, Range 13 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico;

Basin Dakota (Prorated Gas)	(71599)
Basin Fruitland Coal (Gas)	(71629)

and from the following diversely owned wells located on a federal lease in said Section, Township, and Range in San Juan County, New Mexico:

The commingled gas production shall be measured and sold at the Bell Federal Gas Com "A" No. 1E (CTB) located in Unit E, Section 12, Township 13 North, Range 13 West, San Juan County, NMPM, New Mexico.


Gas production from for the Bell Federal 12 No. 2 shall be calculated by subtracting the volume for the Bell Federal Gas Com "A" No. 1E. The Bell Federal Gas Com "A" No. 1E shall be equipped with an allocation meter. The allocation meter shall be calibrated quarterly in accordance with Rule 19.15.12.10.C (2) NMAC.

The operator shall notify the transporter of this commingling authority.

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The operator shall notify the Aztec District Office of the Division upon commencement of commingling operations.
