Environmental Records indicate 396 yd ³ of impacted material was transported to the SUG Landfarm during this time. On December 7, 2012, the site was revisited in an effort to determine if soil exhibiting benzene, BTEX, TPH and chloride concentrations above NMOCD regulatory standards remained in-situ and collect confirmation soil samples. Laboratory analytical results from the confirmation soil samples suggested previous remediation activities met the requirements of the NMOCD.
