

Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.* **On September 23, 2014 a valve was opened by livestock causing the release of 66 barrels of produced water. No fluids were recovered due to flooding. The flow path subsequently ran southeast across the location. The area affected ran south of the load-outs approximately 243-feet long and 8 to 10-feet wide. The flow path left the location to the south into the pasture approximately 75-feet long by 25-feet wide. Talon/LPE was contracted to perform an initial site assessment and soil sampling to generate a work plan.**

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.* **The area affected ran south of the load-outs approximately 243-feet long and 8 to 10-feet wide. The flow path left the location to the west into the pasture approximately 75-feet long by 25-feet wide. Talon/LPE was contracted to perform an initial site assessment and soil sampling.**
