Subject: Lost Tank 4 Federal #19 Battery

This is to inform you that Oxy Permian Primary NM South had a leak at the Lost Tank 4 Federal #19 Battery on November 3, 2014. Oxy spilled 10 bbls of oil and 30 bbls of produced water due to corrosion of a 2" steel production flow line. The preliminary report shows the leak measuring approximately 90' x 60' with the leak located on and off location. No fluids were recovered. The release is located in U/L J, Section 4, T22S, R31E of Eddy County, NM. BBC International will remediate the location at a later date and an initial C-141 will follow.
