
Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.\*

Due to low temperatures, hydrates formed at various locations along the pipeline. Multiple pipeline blowdowns were performed to remove the hydrates; the blowdowns were all in the same vicinity. The total volume for all blowdown events was 106.5 MCF. Pipeline liquids were collected and temporarily stored in frac tanks until removed from the location via tanker trucks. No liquids were released to the ground.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.\*

No liquid spills occurred requiring any cleanup actions.
